

About the museum

The Museum of the Memory of the Earth in Tataouine is a Tunisian museum with a historical, geological and archaeological dimension. It was founded on April 1, 2000 and is located in the city of Tataouine in the south of the country. Following cooperation between the National Office of Mines and the Regional Council of Tataouine, the Museum of the Memory of the Earth was resurrected on April 1, 2000, and collects the most radioactive fossils On the side, including dinosaurs and reptiles

The museum displays many skeletal structures of extinct dinosaurs and animals, as well as animal or plant fossils.

The museum also hosts the Tataouine meteorite that fell in the region on June 27, 1931 and weighs 12 kilograms.

There are several remains of the skeletons of Spinosaurus dinosaurs that were found in the area.



About the archaeological site :

Chenini (Tataouine) is the name of a village located in the Tataouine wilaya in southern Tunisia, about 16 km to the southwest from the center of the wilaya. It is located on top of a hill near a modern village of the same name. It was established by mixed Berbers and Arabs in a mountainous area, as it was built on top of a hill. Its oldest buildings date back to the twelfth century. It
